



NSCC EDUCATION FUND SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS 2008 – 2009

Submit one application with all required materials to the NSCC Ed Fund Office (2nd Floor of College Center building near President's Office) **by 4:30 pm on Wednesday, April 30, 2008**. Do not wait until the last day to obtain signatures! Submit only one application; you will be considered for every Ed Fund Scholarship for which you are eligible.

Please note: International Students should apply for scholarship funding through the International Student Programs Office. Please call ISP at (206) 527 3672.

Minimum Requirements:

- Submit a one-page, personal typewritten letter outlining your background, financial need, educational goals, and personal challenges. This will serve as your opportunity to appeal to the committee with any special consideration you feel is relevant, and to clarify or highlight your academic record. Bear in mind that you are requesting financial assistance; explain your reasons for doing so (if appropriate, include a list of your resources and need). Format your letter appropriately: it **must** include your name, address information, date, and signature, and it **must** be addressed to the Members of the Scholarship Committee. *Free computers are available in the library.*
- You must be attending classes at North Seattle Community College and have completed at least one quarter in the Seattle Community College district *prior to application*.
- Provide a current Seattle Community College District transcript (official or unofficial—class schedules are not acceptable substitutes).
- Complete the attached application, including the two Faculty recommendation signatures.
If you are unable to obtain Faculty recommendation signatures, you must submit a note explaining why as well as two Letters of Recommendation from employers, community leaders, or North staff members.
- To retain scholarship eligibility, you must be enrolled for at least 10 credits each quarter and maintain a 2.0 GPA.

IMPORTANT FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION:

- To be considered for financial need-based scholarships, students must complete the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** for the **2008 - 2009** academic year (available online at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov>). In order to meet the ED Fund scholarship application deadline of April 30, 2008, it is recommended that the FAFSA application be submitted one to two months prior to the deadline. In addition to the FAFSA, the NSCC Data Sheet (available at the Financial Aid office or online at <http://www.northseattle.edu/enroll/finance/download.htm>) needs to be submitted to the Financial Aid office by April 30, 2008.
